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For each required disclosure a of a registrant's Scopes 1 and 2 emissions, registrants would be required to disclose the emissions both disaggregated by each constituent GHG and in the aggregate, expressed in terms of metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent (CO₂e). CO₂e is the common unit of measurement used by the GHG Protocol to indicate global warming potential (GWP) of each GHG, expressed in terms of the GWP of one unit of carbon dioxide.

A registrant would be required to describe the methodology, significant inputs, and significant assumptions used to calculate its GHG emissions. Corcentric's Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction and Reporting Strategy reports on scope 1 direct GHG emissions resulting from the operation of owned or leased mobile combustion sources which are within an organization's inventory boundary. The combustion of fossil fuel results in three of the seven constituent GHGs covered by the Kyoto Protocol including ${\rm CO}_{2^{\prime}}$ ${\rm CH}_4$ and ${\rm N}_2{\rm O}$.
